



SUNDAY MOUNTAIN SAUVIGNON BLANC 2009 **Marlborough, New Zealand**

The hottest white wine today next to German Riesling, and Italian Pinot Grigio is New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc...and when you can find it with a pedigree (Marlborough Country) you have a winner.

Sunday Mountain is an American/ New Zealand joint venture with R. Shack Selections and Ian Marchand, winemaker to find a Sauvignon Blanc that over delivers for the price. The label depicts a small mountain rise outside of the wine city of Blenheim, where “Blenheimers piquenique” in the summer time.

Sunday Mountain is a fantasy name, but dubbed by the residents as a great weekend destination.

Our taste profile includes the obligatory “gooseberry” nose, but we seek more of a citrus and grapefruit finish, giving it more of a softer texture, linked with good acidity, this makes for a great aperitif full of zingyness.
