The Estate

Historically, the planting of red wine grape varieties had been prohibited in the Mosel Valley since the middle of the 18th century. In 1986, Pinot's renaissance came about with the plantings of Pinot Noir vineyards around the Mittelmosel village of Mehring. These historic parcels serve as the base of Nik Weis Pinot Noir Rosé today. The soil is a mix of river sediments and soft, blue Devon slate, rich in nutrients. The microclimate around the village of Mehring is strongly influenced by the Mosel River which reflects the sunlight and collects the warmth of the daily sun while the nights remain cool. Both natural effects lead to better growing conditions for the vines thus better grape qualities for winemaking.

Wine Making

The Pinot Noir grapes are harvested by hand and after a short maceration, are gently pressed to produce the wine's gorgeous pale salmon hue. The must undergoes a spontaneous or 'wild' fermentation at cool temperatures (i.e. no cultured yeast is added). The wine is bottled soon after fermentation to retain freshness and vivacity.

Tasting Notes

This pretty wine is perfect for sipping and savoring. It is buoyant and fresh with aromas and flavors of blueberry, raspberry and strawberry alongside hints of rose petals and fresh herbs, including woodruff, lilac and elderflower.
